

Direction and Position

Using simple objects, the student will demonstrate an understanding of concept words associated with direction and position.

Put a book, a small toy, and a baseball hat on the table in front of the student. Ask the student to listen carefully and follow these directions.

- OPEN the book.
- CLOSE the book.
- Put the hat ON your head.
- Take the hat OFF your head.
- Put the book BEHIND your chair.
- Hold the toy UPSIDE DOWN.
- Put the book UP and put it ON the table.
- Take the toy OUT OF the hat.
- Put the toy UNDER your chair.
- Hold the hat HIGH OVER your head.
- Put the toy ON TOP OF the book.
- Put your hands AROUND the toy.
- Put the hat NEXT TO the book.
- Put your hands TOGETHER IN your lap.
