

Carousel

Morphology

Carousel is a one-minute timed, rotating, learning strategy where students create words based on an affix, root, or base word.

Preparation:

- Teacher will hang up six sheets of poster paper around the room with a different affix, root, or base word written at the top of each poster.
- A routine and signal for rotating
- Groups assigned and markers for each student



Procedure:

1. Teacher will have students get in groups.
2. At the signal, students rotate to a poster and write words that contain the affix, root, or base word written at the top of the poster.
3. After one-minute, signal is given and the students will rotate to the next poster.
4. Continue through all the posters.

Variation:

Write a different word on each poster. Groups will add other words in that same word family.
