PHONICS: Read and spell words with digraph ch

WARM UP

Materials:

2 min. High Frequency Irregular Words

Flash Cards

STATE THE WHY

1 min. **Purpose:** We are learning to read and spell words with the digraph ch.

Goal: At the end of this lesson you will recognize that the letters ch together spells the sound /ch/ and be able to accurately read and spell words with the digraph ch.

REVIEW:

2 min. Segment, write, and read words with digraphs sh and th.
Review words: wish, shop, path, thud

TEACH THE SKILL

Materials:

15 mins. **Alphabetic Principle:** Today we will learn a new digraph ch. Remember digraphs are two letters that go together to make one sound. **Ch** says /ch/ as in chair. (Students will repeat the sound and write the letters.)

DIRECT Instruction Strategy:
Phoneme Grapheme Mapping

I do: chip, chat, much
We do: chap, chug, *NSW word - choz*
You do: chap, chin, *NSW words - chiz, cheth, chish*

Dictation:
Sounds: /sh/, /th/, /ch/,
Irregularly spelled HFW: who, said, would
Words: shin, chub, mesh; *NSW words: ched, thod, chosh*
Sentence: Chad would chat all day.

MEANINGFUL GUIDED PRACTICE

Materials:

5 min. Reading Words and Sentences - (NO sound by sound, only Touch the Vowel, and Read the Word)

I do: model
We do: practice
You do: read, checkers, all read

ch words, phrases, sentences and passages

RESTATE THE WHY

1 min. **What did we learn?** We learned how to read and spell words with the digraph ch. What sound does the letters ch make?

Why did we learn it? It is important to know that when we see these two letters together they do not say /k/ /h/. When we see the letters ch together it says /ch/ and when we hear /ch/ in a word we are spelling, we use the ch letters.

Turn to your partner and tell them what you learned.
